STAGE 1 SETTINGS ASSESSMENT (SCOPING) FOR HISTORIC ASSETS

Table 1 details the outcome of the Stage 1 scoping exercise to identify historic assets to be included within the detailed ES assessment of effects arising through change to setting. All designated assets within the 3km study have been considered and are presented on **Figure 9.1** and are mapped with the Zones of Theoretical Visibility (ZTV) in **Figure 9.2**. The designated assets scoped in and visited were chosen in reference to the ZTV or due to their proximity to the Site (see **Chapter 9, Section 9.6**)
